Gerhard Budin is a full professor of terminology studies and translation technologies at the University of Vienna, Austria. He is the deputy director of the Center for Translation Studies, one of the 18 faculties of the University of Vienna. He teaches and carries out research on topics such as technical translation, terminology, technical communication, linguistics, translation technologies, and language engineering. He is chair of an international standards committee (ISO TC 37 Sub-Committee 2).

Sue Ellen Wright is a Professor of German and a member of the Kent State University Institute for Applied Linguistics. She teaches computer applications for translators and German to English technical translation. She is chair of the American Translators Association (ATA) Terminology Committee and ATA certified for German to English translation. She is the chair of the US mirror group for ISO TC 37, Terminology and other language and content resources. She is active as a terminology trainer and consultant for companies and institutions implementing terminology management in localization environments, and is the compiler with Gerhard Budin of the Handbook of Terminology Management.

Camilla Nielsen is a professor of Conference Interpreting at the Center for Translation Studies at the University of Vienna. She also specializes in the literature, philosophical movements, and culture of fin de siècle Vienna.
